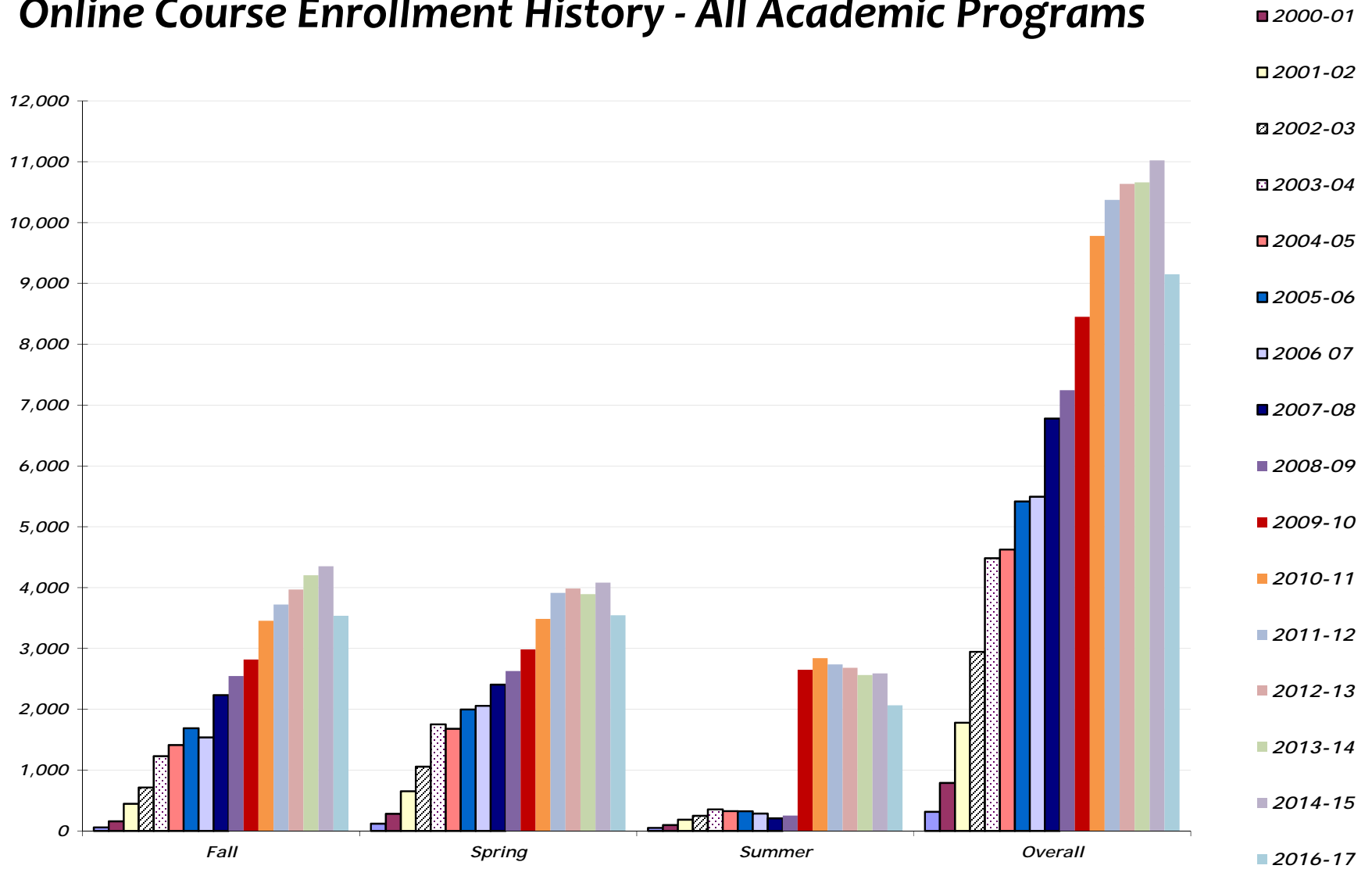




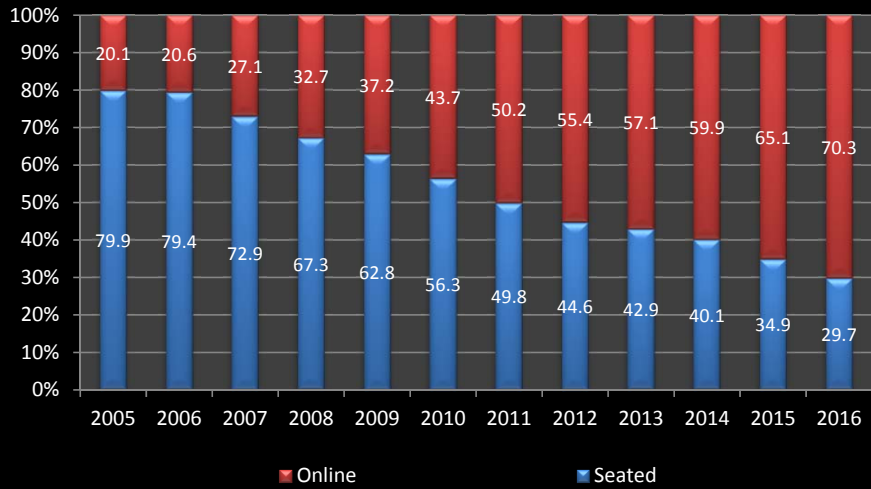

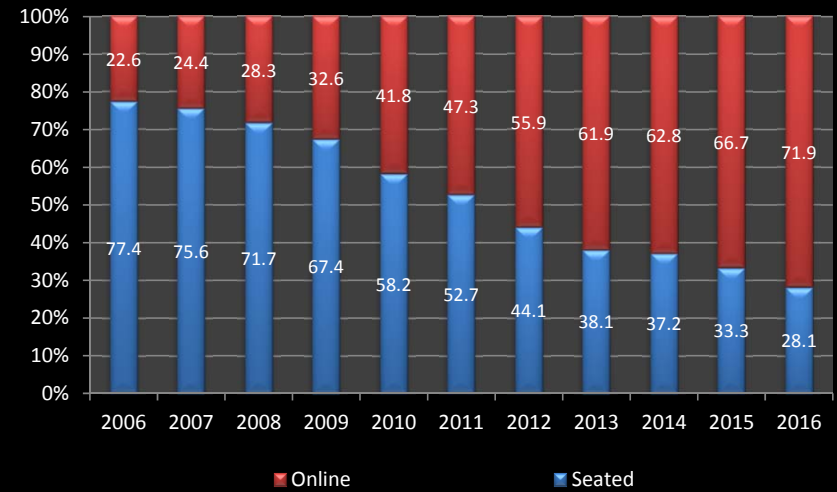
# Online Course Enrollment History - All Academic Programs



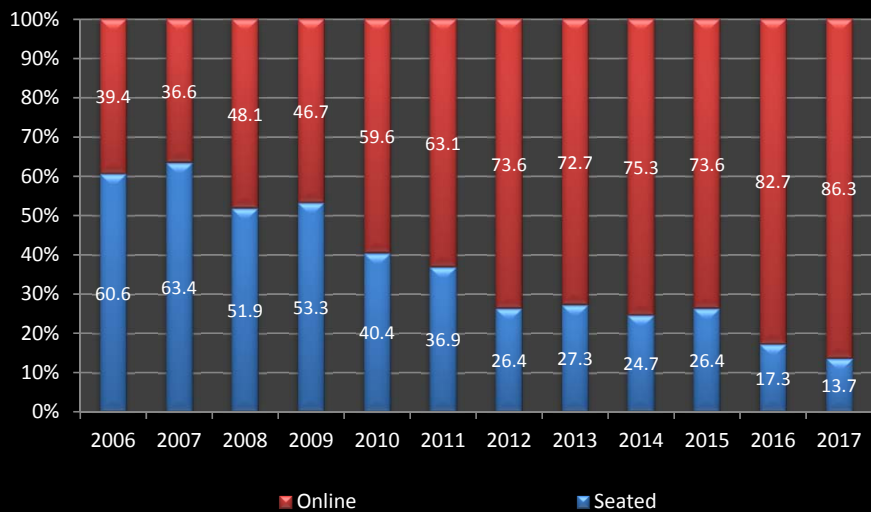
**COMPARISON OF ONLINE AND SEATED ENROLLMENT HOURS  
DCP PROGRAM - FALL SEMESTERS**



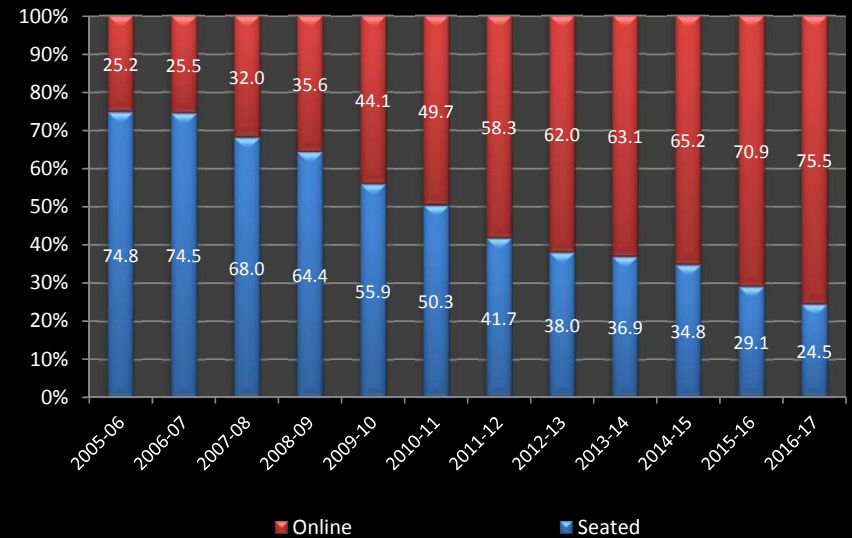
**COMPARISON OF ONLINE AND SEATED ENROLLMENT HOURS

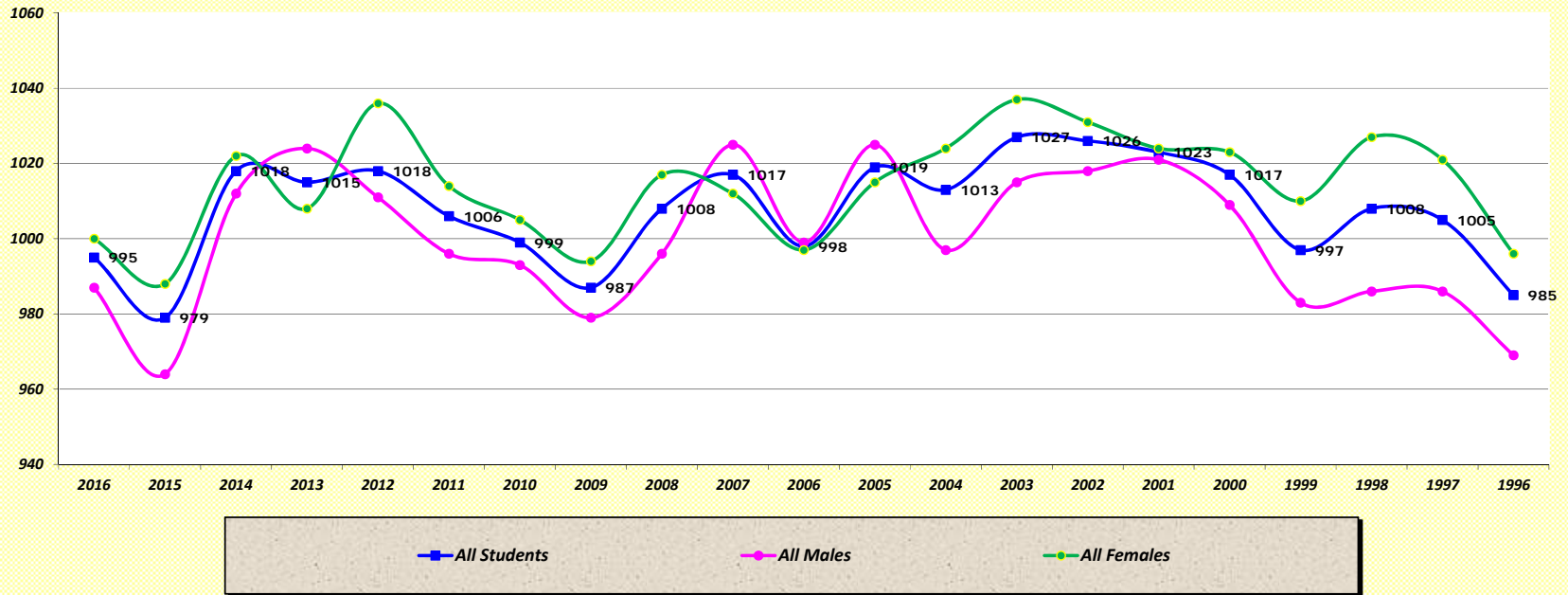

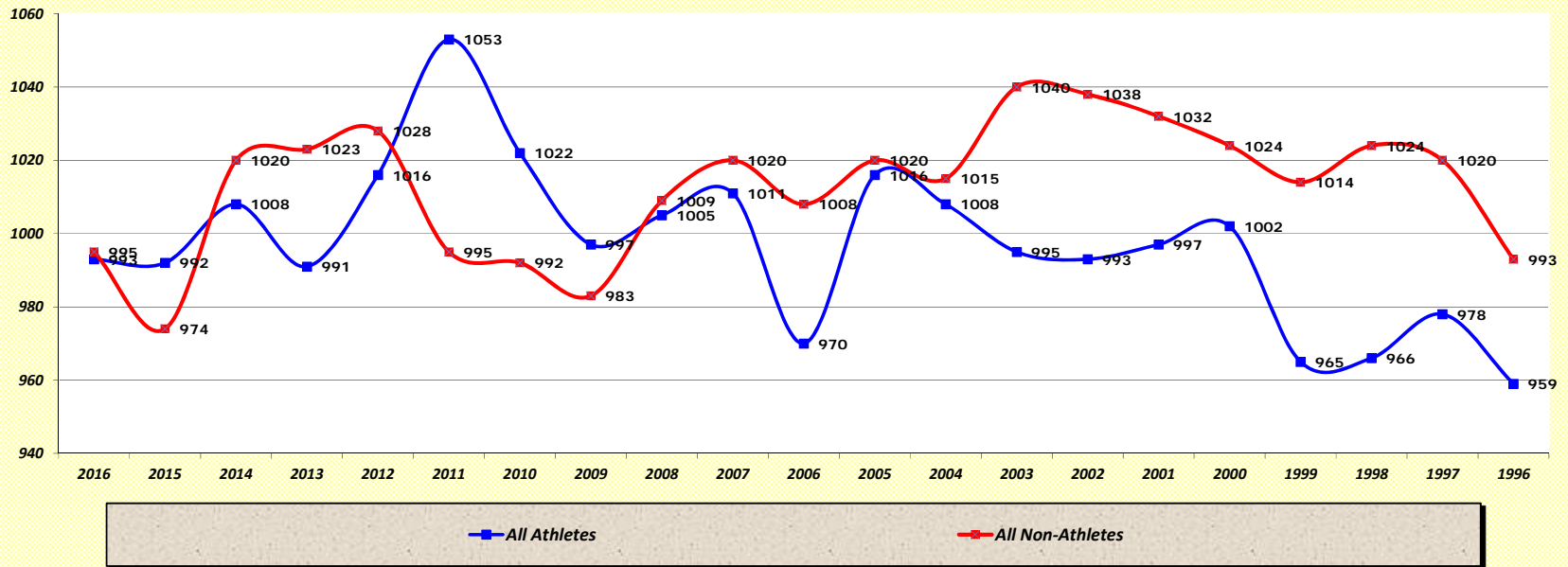
