

Enrolled CDT

Can Become

A Student that: -wants to "try" ROTC
-Has no prior Svc & is a junior or senior
-Has no interest in serving in the Army but wants leadership & management instruction and/or adventure training
- Is not yet eligible to contract

Contracted CDT's

Features: +Stipend, +Army Schools (Airborne, Air Assault, Mountain Warfare, etc...)

●8-Year total obligation = AD/USAR or NG/IRR

AD (Active Duty), USAR (United States Army Reserve), NG (National Guard), IRR (Individual Ready Reserve)

Can Take

100 & 200 level courses and
330 & 311

End of course work

With this path:

-No Benefits (i.e. scholarship, books allowance or stipend)

But:

+No military obligation

Non-Scholarship

- Obligation: 3/0/5 or 0/6/2
- + Retain GI Bill
- Can't contract non-scholarship until soph. year

SMP

(Simultaneous

Membership Program)

NON-SMP

- No additional benefits or obligations

- Drill 1x per month

- GRFD non-scholarship option

- + Receives E5 Drill Pay

- + Experience leading

- Soldiers as shadow PL

Scholarship

Features:

- Obligation: 4/0/4 or 0/8/0
- + Scholarship pays tuition and fees
- + GWU pays room and board
- + Book money (\$600/semester)

GRFD

- Drill 1x per month
- Obligation 0/9/0 (No AD option)
- + Receive E5 Drill Pay
- + Experience leading
- Soldiers as Shadow PL

Non-AD GRFD

- Keep/use GI Bill Benefits
- + Can choose either NG or USAR
- Only 2 year scholarship

Regular

(Active Duty – AD)

- Do Not Drill
- Student Loan Repayment Program if AD
- + 4,3, or 2 year Scholarship
- No Drill Pay
- Lose G.I. Bill Benefits (until obligation complete)

NG or USAR Advance Designee

- + 3 Year & 2 Year Scholarship
- Once you choose NG or USAR, you are committed
- Lose Future GI Bill Benefits (until obligation complete)
