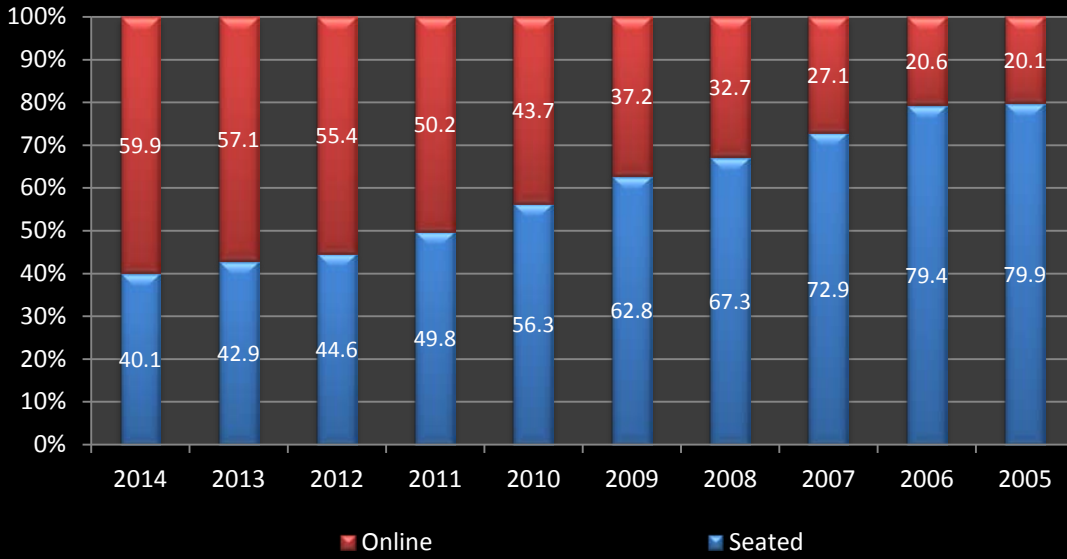

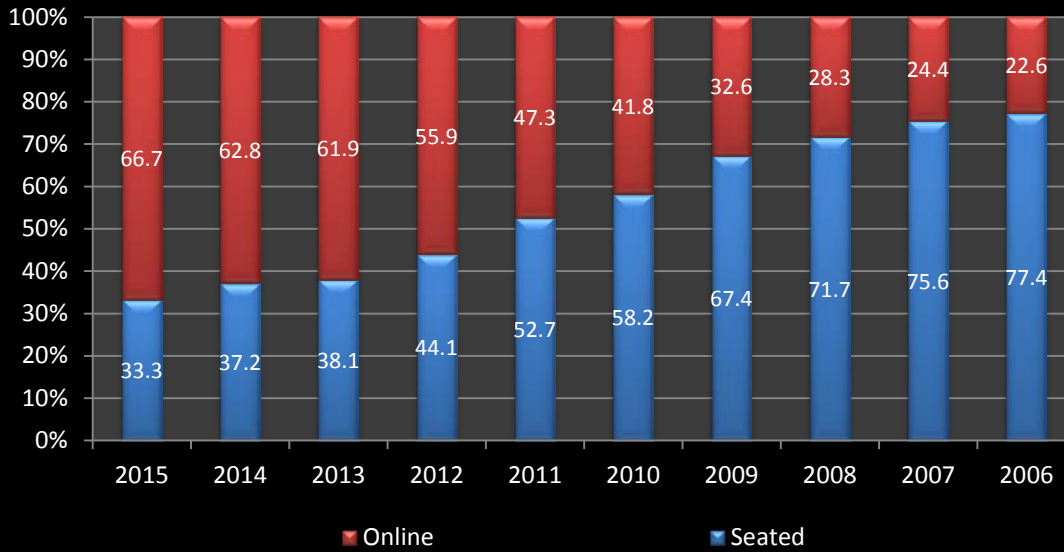

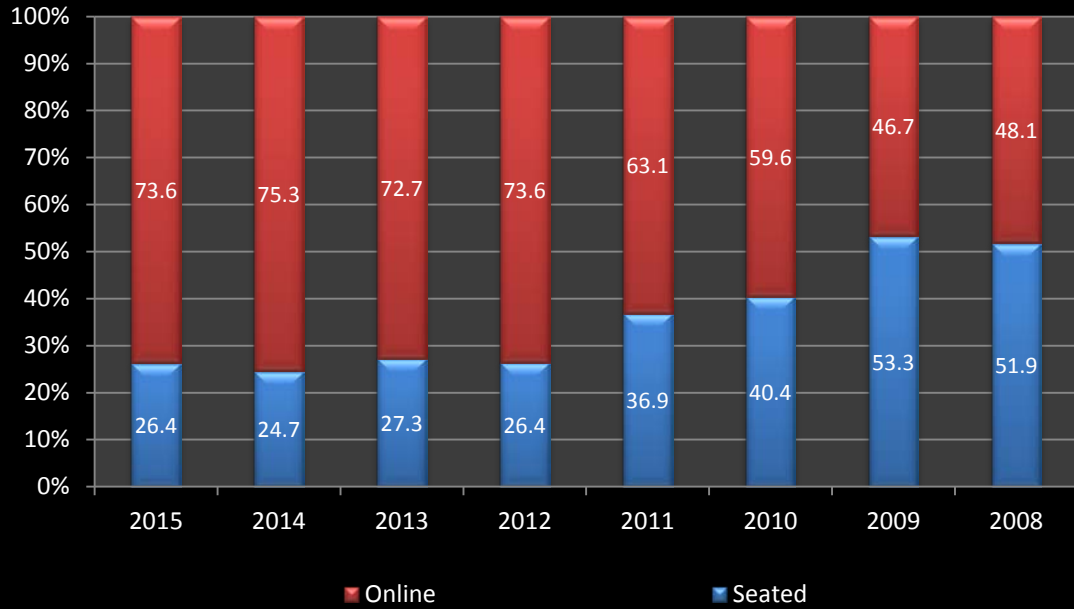
COMPARISON OF ONLINE AND SEATED ENROLLMENT HOURS DCP PROGRAM - FALL SEMESTERS



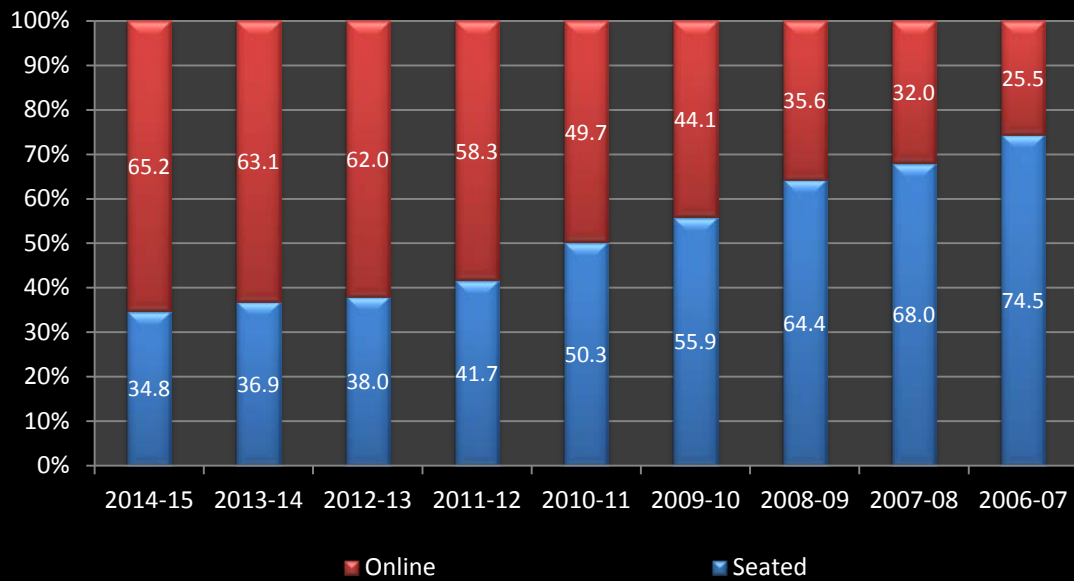
COMPARISON OF ONLINE AND SEATED ENROLLMENT HOURS DCP PROGRAM - SPRING SEMESTERS

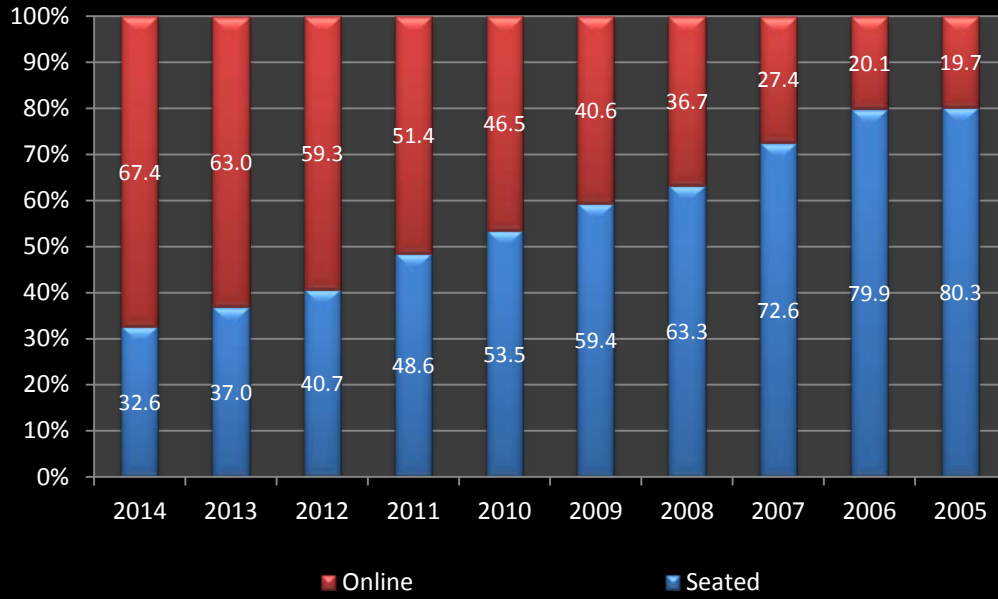

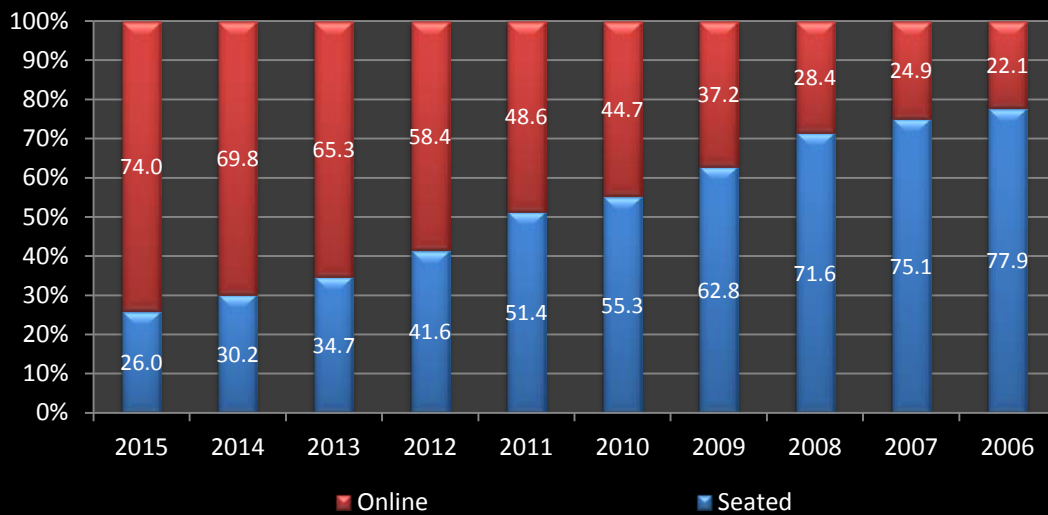

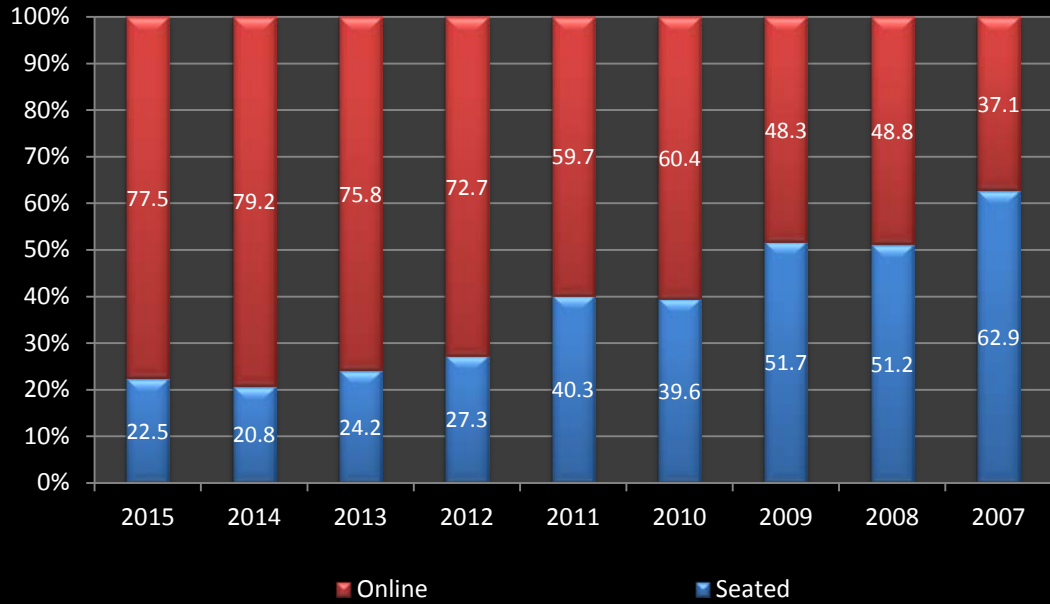
COMPARISON OF ONLINE AND SEATED ENROLLMENT HOURS DCP PROGRAM and BSN - FALL SEMESTERS



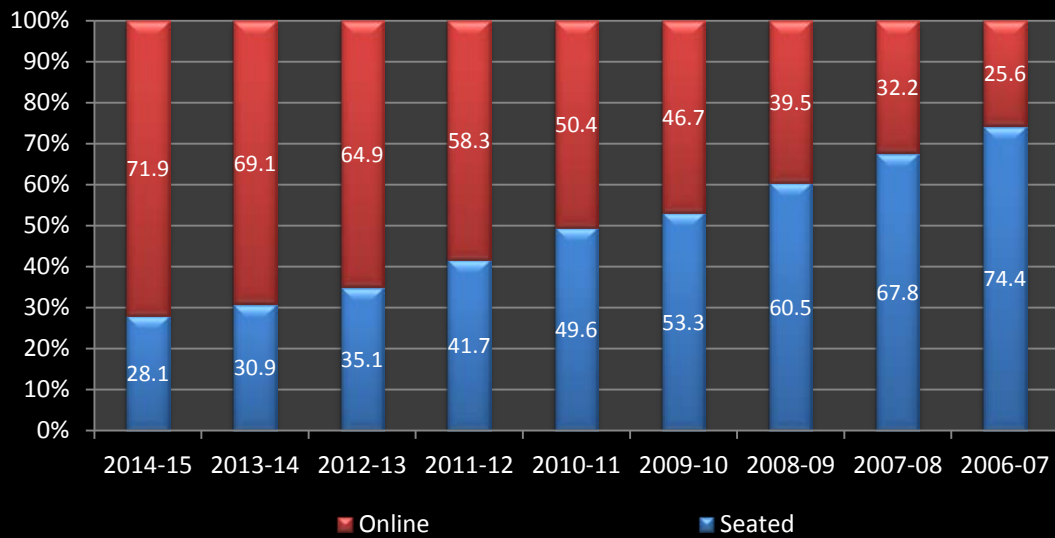
COMPARISON OF ONLINE AND SEATED ENROLLMENT HOURS

Excellence in Teaching Award

In 1977, Gardner-Webb's Alpha Chi Honor Society initiated the annual process of recognizing the University's most outstanding member of the full-time teaching faculty. The chapter's nominations were presented to the faculty and the final vote was taken at the March general faculty meeting.

Beginning in 1987, a select committee consisting of administrators, alumni, faculty and students was established to receive nominations from various quarters and identify that year's winner. Known as the Fleming-White Award from 1987-2002, the recognition is now known as Gardner-Webb University's Outstanding Professor Award.
