ACADEMIC GUIDELINES

- 1) Acceptance into Organizational Leadership requires completion of an Associate's Degree and minimum 2.5 GPA.
- 2) A student can receive transfer credit for courses according to this list of equivalencies set forth within the attached Transfer Plan. To receive credit for a course, a student must have earned a "C" 2.0 or better in that course. Other courses taken will be evaluated for transfer on a course by course basis by the Gardner-Webb University Registrar Services.
- 3) Students who do not have transfer credit for ENG 101, will need to register for this course during their first semester.
- 4) Enrollment in LIB 301 is mandatory each semester until the course is successfully completed.
- 5) Grades of "C" (2.0) or higher are required on all major courses.
- 6) A "C minus" or lower will not meet graduation requirements and the course will need to be repeated at GWU.
- 7) A minimum grade point average of 2.00 on a 4.00 scale is required for graduation on all course work attempted at GWU (see institution GPA).
- 8) Completion of a minimum of 64 credit hours with Gardner-Webb is required to be considered for graduation honors.
- 9) Students transferring from accredited two-year colleges may transfer up to 64 semester hours. Students are required to complete a minimum of 64 credit hours at senior (4-year) colleges or universities, with at least the final 32 hours with Gardner-Webb.
- 10) Students must complete at least 128 total semester hours and meet all curriculum requirements in order to be eligible for graduation.
- 11) The student bears the final responsibility for the selection of a program of study and adherence to all the published regulations and requirements of the University, including the requirements for graduation.
- 12) At least 15 credit hours of the major course requirements must be completed at GWU.
