****NOTE: Students will not be permitted to complete more than 50% of the Professional Education minor (excluding student teaching) until they are formally admitted into the Teacher Education program. Once admitted, students must maintain a 3.0 GPA or higher. Students seeking Spanish licensure K12 are required to pass the ACTLF OPI with a proficiency level of at least Intermediate High prior to beginning Student Teaching. Students are encouraged to enter the Teacher Education program the semester after successful completion of EDUC 250. Students seeking K-12 Spanish licensure are encouraged to pass the Praxis II licensing exam during the last year of study before graduation.*
