## Academic Guidelines

1. A student can receive transfer credit for courses according to the list of equivalencies set forth within the attached Transfer Plan. To receive credit for a course, a student must have earned a "C" (2.0) or better in



that course. Other courses taken will be evaluated for transfer on a course-by-course basis by Gardner-Webb University's Registrar Services.

- 2. Up to 90 transfer hours could be awarded for RN-to-BSN transfer students. For a bachelor's degree, the final 30 credit hours for graduation must be taken at Gardner-Webb.
- 3. Transfer hours and program requirements may vary and are dependent upon the individual student's transfer work.
- 4. Students must complete at least the final 30 credit hours at GWU to be eligible for graduation honors.
- 5. Under the terms of this Nursing Bridge Agreement, qualifying community college students are accepted seamlessly into the RN-to-BSN, MSN, and ADN at Gardner-Webb upon acceptance into the community college's ADN program.
